The Cannabis Impact Fund grew and expanded the work we do to contribute to racial equity in the cannabis sector and beyond. What a journey we have been on.We created the Cannabis Impact Fund at a time when there were real barriers for our sector to participate in a larger effort. Our experience with our sister for profit agency, Cannabis Doing Good, showed us how hard it was for cannabis companies to contribute to nonprofit efforts. Navigating nonprofits and federal prohibition was a challenge we were prepared to meet. In our 3rd year, the Cannabis Impact Fund has made doing the right thing, the easy thing by contributing to the racial equity work of folks fully entrenched in it. Twenty-twenty-three helped us to determine how important we are in the cannabis ecosystem. It's time to step up!



OUR MISSION



Cannabis Impact Fund's mission is to promote racial justice, environmental sustainability, and to support communities by leveraging a conscious cannabis sector. Launched in the Summer of 2020 in the middle of the Movement for Black Lives, we are dedicated to supporting nationwide nonprofits that center racial justice by providing bi-annual grants to our five selected grantees: The Bail Project, Black Futures Lab, Color of Change, Minorities for Medical Marijuana and the Hood Incubator.

THE WORK WE DO



We donated more than \$100K to five national nonprofits since the fall of 2020.




